All Souls Day (Thursday, November 2nd) will have two mases at 9am and 6pm. All three masses (the vigil on Wednesday and the two on Thursday morning) will be for the repose of the souls of our relatives and friends who are deceased.

As well as the masses on All Souls Day, **individual masses** for the names on the envelopes will be said at St Lucia on weekdays or weekends before the end of the year. If there are some remaining, Fr Pat will celebrate them when he retires at Canossa.

It has been suggested that we should go back to using **hymn books**. We can put them on **trolleys** at the three exits, to be picked up and returned at the end of mass. Any hymns not in the books can put in the newsletter. Fr Pat will discuss this with the new parish priest.
