Fr Chris Hanlon PhD, MA will be celebrating all **masses at St Lucia next weekend**. He is the current Archdiocesan historian; his specialty is the Archdiocese in colonial Brisbane and has a further interest in Pope St Gregory the Great. He has administered in many parishes including Sandgate, Wilston, Sunnybank, Acacia Ridge, Ashgrove, Caboolture, Burleigh Heads. We welcome him to St Lucia.

During the recent **Plenary Council**, Catholics from across Australia **passed 18 proposals**. **Four particular proposals of significance are:**

- Committing Catholic churches and organisations to respond to the **climate crisis**.
- Make changes to policies and practices around **women in the Church**, ensuring they are **appropriately represented in decision-making and equally remunerated** in employment.
- Ensure **leaders have a strong foundation in their faith**
- For the Catholic Church in Australia to formally apologise to First Nations Peoples and **actively work towards reconciliation**.
